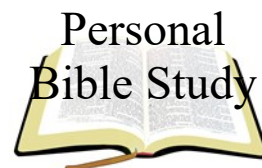

GOD IS ALL AROUND US. He is not far from you. “*For in Him we live and move and have our being*” (Acts 17:27). The Bible and the church are accessible to everyone. Yet the world, and even religion seem to be moving further away from God’s righteousness. Because of this, people continue to needlessly suffer the physical and spiritual consequences of sin.

Many people are trying to build relationships with God, through nature, feelings, and personal religious traditions; instead of through Jesus Christ, His Words and His Church.

THINK ABOUT THIS: everything you know and believe about the one true God, is confirmed by or comes from the Bible. Otherwise, we would all be lost in idolatry or atheism. So if you want to have a saving relationship with the one true God, you must take time to read His instructions and revelation to mankind, take time to understand it and be willing to obey what God says you should do to be saved.

THE BIBLE. The Bible is God’s only inspired revelation for mankind. And it is written for you, so you can understand it (2 Peter 1:20-21). It tells you everything you need to know about why He created you, why you are here, how you should live and worship, and how to prepare for death, and His return (Acts 17:22-31). It has two main covenants and laws (Hebrews 8:7-8). The second covenant comes through Jesus’ blood (Luke 22:20) and its laws for life and worship are found primarily from Acts chapter 2 to Revelation 22. In the Gospels, you will see Jesus pointing to the day when the Holy Spirit would guide the Apostles into all truth, which He did (John 16:13). And which is why the laws for the New Covenant is also called the Apostles’ doctrines (Acts 2:42, Jude 3, 1 John 4:1-6).

SALVATION. Salvation is freedom from the punishment of sins (John 3:16, Rom. 6:23). And it comes through the blood of Jesus (1 Pet. 1:18-19, Rev. 1:5). Sin is any thought or action that goes against God’s laws (1 John 3:4). In order to be saved by grace through faith, Jesus says “*you must be born of the water and the Spirit*” (John 3:3-8). This is done by immersion in water (Acts 2:38). When you are baptized, you are sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise (Acts 2:38, Eph. 1:13).

The Spirit will also become your spiritual help, especially in your prayer relationship with God (Rom. 8:26). God knows that we all sin, so He provides help and forgiveness for His children, when we confess and repent of our sins (1 John 1:8-10). As His children, we help each other remain faithful in life and worship until Jesus calls us home, or until He returns for His church (Acts 2:42, Rev. 2:10, John 4:24). **So if you Hear the Gospel, and Believe and confess that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and you are sorry for your sins and willingly Repent, then be baptized today, and wash away your sin, calling on the name of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit (Matt. 28:19, Acts 22:16).**

PUBLIC WORSHIP. After baptism, Jesus adds you to His church (Acts 2:42). And when Jesus returns, He will gather those who are faithful out of His church (Eph. 5:25-27). The church is not optional, it is critical to your eternal salvation.

God desires “true worshippers,” and true worshippers “worship in spirit and truth” (John 4:23-24). When you read the law of the church (the New Testament), you may notice some differences between how many churches worship, live, and how Christians worshipped and lived in the time of the Apostles. Unfortunately, while all churches help people to connect and fellowship, not all are teaching and practicing what Jesus commands, for life and worship (Romans 16:17, 1 Timothy 4). As Jesus says, “Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord shall enter, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven” (Matthew 7:21). In our studies together, we will talk more about the ways God wants Christians to live and worship.

YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD. This is your most important relationship. And you are faithful when you arrange your life and worship according to the written will of God. As you read the scriptures, you may see things that are different from what you have always believed to be pleasing to God, but things that you cannot find in the scriptures (Acts 18:24-26, Romans 10:2). God calls all of us to repent or change and follow His ways, not the ways of our relatives, friends or society.
